Forklift Training Guidelines

It is important that all workplaces utilizing forklifts have the checklist below or one equivalent on the premises. If all of the safety rules are being followed, each of these questions should be answered with a "yes". A "no" to any question indicates a procedural weakness that can lead to accident, injury or damage to machinery.

- 1) Is the forklift operating area separated from pedestrian traffic?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to forklift travel areas restricted by barriers?
- 3) Are pedestrian walkways provided and well marked?
- 4) Are "forklift in operation" signs visibly clear?
- 5) Are mirrors for drivers and pedestrians provided at blind spots?
- 6) Alterations or changes to the daily forklift schedule has been communicated to employees?
- 7) The forklift tires being utilized are suitable for all operating surfaces?
- 8) Is the seatbelt being used?
- 9) Is the seat in good condition?
- 10) The maintenance schedule of the forklift is being followed?
- 11) Are annual inspections of the forklift being carried out?
- 12) Is the forklift right for the needed tasks?
- 13) Does forklift has a load chart that is readable?
- 14) Do all operators know how to read the load chart?
- 15) Does the chart list the safe capacity for different uses and attachments?
- 16) Do the forklift warning devices work properly?
- 17) Is the operating speed control device fitted right?
- 18) The lift truck overhead cage is fitted correctly?
- 19) Do the operators of the forklift have certifications to operate the machine?
- 20) Are speed limits and warning signs being observed?
- 21) The operators have current training for the forklifts being used?
- 22) Forklift operators know their duties to report the damage to the machinery and other forklift incidences?
- 23) Is the pre-test checklist reviewed on a daily basis prior to the machine being used?
