Mississauga Telehandler Certification - A telehandler certification course could be taken by potential operators who have previous experience with driving typical forklifts and for individuals with no previous experiences on a lift truck. The real-world training offered by these programs produces graduates who know the correct and safe utilization of these kinds of equipment.

Telehandler certification courses are offered in two forms: at a training facility; at the job site of the trainee. With the former alternative, the manufacturer can work with a licensing agency to bring individuals to a training facility. This alternative offers trainees with the chance to learn to utilize the machinery in a controlled setting. When completed, participants receive a license or certification to operate this type of equipment.

With the latter alternative, a qualified instructor is sent to a work location in order to provide on-location training. This alternative ensures that the trainee is instructed on actual machinery that would be used on the job, and prepares the trainee for the demands of that particular setting. People training learn about possible dangerous cases that could arise on the actual work place. The instruction focuses on any conditions which are specific to the work location, enabling operators to be ready to handle these elements more safely.

The term "telehandler" is an abbreviated version of "telescopic handler," referring to an equipment which has a telescoping or extending arm supporting a fork. A telehandler has various characteristics and controls just like a forklift. A telehandler has the capability of transporting and lifting loads up and away from the vehicle. Incorrect operation of telehandlers can lead to serious accidents. If load restrictions are exceeded, the machine can tip due to excess weight on the lift. It is the duty of the operator to know load limits and to use these machines safely.

"Conversion" classes are designed for operators who have been certified to make use of a forklift. These conversion classes will teach the differences between the operation of a telehandler and a forklift, all the while trying to avoid repetitive information that the forklift operator is already familiar with. For trainees who have no former experience making use of telehandler machinery, training includes the basic operation and use of the equipment. Some organizations likewise offer refresher programs.
