Mississauga Aerial Lift Training - The mechanized access platform called an aerial work platform is a device that provides access to places which are otherwise not accessible to people and other machine. Likewise called an aerial device or elevating work platform, the machinery is usually utilized to access high areas. Construction and maintenance staff often need to make use of aerial work platforms on the job. They are utilized by firefighters for emergency access.

Designed for temporary application, aerial work platforms are distinguished from elevators, which provide permanent access to high places. An aerial work platform is intended to be operated by a single person, and can lift weights of less than one ton. Various kinds have higher load limits. There are various kinds of aerial work platforms; like for example, there is a "scissor lift" and a "cherry picker".

Several aerial work platforms come equipped along with compressed air connectors for power tools or electrical outlets. For specialist tasks, such as lifting frames for window glass, an aerial work platform can come with special tools.

Individuals who would like to operate an aerial lift device have to undergo training. Usually, the members of a Health & Safety Committee and their representatives are responsible for the inspection of every equipment and work areas and are likewise needed to undergo training. Those training will become familiar with how to utilize an aerial lift device. They will also know the regulations which apply to safely utilizing these machinery. Regulations vary within various provinces, and in worksites that are federally regulated.

Workers who work near or are required to be lifted by an aerial lifting machine has to be aware of all the possible hazards. An Aerial Lift Training Video could be shown in a general safety session to educate all of the workers who are lifted by them or work near them.

Most Aerial Lift Training Program will include modules that are focused on the following areas: Aerial Lift Devices and Operating Controls; Hazard Identification; Pre Operational Checks for Aerial Lift Devices; and Platform Positioning & Park Positioning. The particular program is meant to train employees on the safe operation of self-propelled, boom supported elevated work platform and self-propelled, elevated work platform. Workers who complete the program will receive a certificate, signed by a qualified individual to verify the successful completion of a hands-on practical exam.
